**GO Blog** http://go-gcc.org The idea for CATALYST took root years ago when I read a book about discipleship entitled Change Agent. I remembered my college chemistry class and the function and characteristics of a change agent known as a catalyst. I wondered then – and still do – if a witness for Christ isn't a great deal like a catalyst. Then in the 1970's automobiles came out with catalytic converters\* and I was sure my thinking was right. "Catalytic Converter" seemed like a good description for Billy Graham.

"Catalysis is the process in which the rate of a chemical reaction is either increased or decreased by means of a chemical substance known as no tast. The catalyst may participate in multiple chemical transformations. Catalysts that speed the reaction are called positive catalysts. Satalysts that show down the reaction are called negative catalysts or inhibitors."

Did you notice words like process, multiple, transformations, positive & negative? And the definition goes on to say, "... the reaction rate depends on the frequency of contact of the reactant..."

"Although catalysts are not consumed by the reaction itself, they may be inhibited, deactivated or destroyed by secondary processes." Sort of reminds me of the big three negative "secondary processes" believers face: The World, the Flesh and the Devil.


Like most metaphors, this one falls apart at some points. Chemists know that a catalyst is not consumed by the reaction itself. Whew! That is not true for many who testify of the claims of Christ in extremely hostile environments of physical disease and personal dangers. I believe the first missionary said something about being poured out like a drink offering, and having fought a good fight, he finished the race, and kept the faith" (2 Timothy 4:6-7).

Then they got into a big 4-wheel drive truck and drove 3 hours to the village. The last 11 km. (7 miles) of that trip was an off-road adventure! The driver called it the "worst road in PNG" as he laughed hysterically!

Mick believes that he is correct in his assessment of the road! They forded two rivers, slid over muddy crevices, and slipped down steep embankments – it took an hour to travel the 11 km. And when Mick got there his cell phone worked!

the principle of "redemptive analogy"- of finding customs and traditions within a culture that can be used to present the Gospel in an understandable and non-foreign way.

Jesus regularly used this communication tool when he said, "The kingdom of God is like..." Read Matthew 13:44. Is it not clear how valuable the kingdom really is?



When Scott took us to visit this family, he and another of our travelling team jumped into the corral and wrestled the beasts to the ground by grabbing their horns and tails along with the herdsman and his heroic wife.

This is the sort of ministry that wins the hearts of a Mongolian nomad.

Renewal. We all need renewal, even missionaries; no, especially missionaries!

The unique stresses and demands of living in a new and radically difference, even hostile culture and the lack of a supporting group of friends, can really lead to spiritual dryness, deadness, silence. Missionaries are not "Super Saints', immune to periods of spiritual drought.

We must support them in prayer.

Remember what Paul said to Titus about our initial renewal? Titus 3: 4-7 "But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life." Well, additional renewal is also a much welcomed gift.

For our missionaries, let's pray the prayer of Lamentations 5:21 "Restore us to yourself, O Lord, that we may be restored! Renew our days as of old." And while we pray let's do so keeping in mind 3:22, "The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness, 'The Lord is my portion,' says my soul, 'therefore I will hope in him.'''

## **THE MBB's OF IRAN**

Excerpts From An Article In The Sept/Oct Issue Of MISSIONS FRONTIERS

"The only way we're going to stop them is to kill them." This seems to be the present consensus of Iran's national cabinet concerning the growing Christ-ward movement spreading throughout the nation. Legislation is now being prepared that would make it a capital offense to leave Islam. These strict measures have come about to stem the tide of a growing dissatisfaction with Islam among Persian young people resulting from the Iranian Revolution of 1979.

Today, it seems Iran is on the verge of yet another revolution, ironically caused by the first and with Jesus at the center. The story of how this has come about is perhaps one of the most intriguing examples of God's sovereignty at work to accomplish His unchanging purposes among the nations.

The Only Way Were Going To Stop Them Is To Kill Them." This Seems To Be The Present Consensus Of Iran's National Cabinet Concerning The Growing Christ-Ward Movement Spreading Throughout The Nation. In the early 1960s, just two decades before Iran would become completely closed to mission work, a team of American missionaries began a work among the Persian Armenian community in Tehran. Most of these Armenians were the descendants of a forced exile to Iran in 1604 under the Shah Abbas. Over the centuries they developed a unique culture, dialect, and appearance (don't ask) as they assimilated with their host nation.

The missionanes recognized the potentiar for these Persian Armenians to serve as a "bridge-people" between Islam and Christianity, and so began work among them with this in mind.

This Spirit-led hunch turned out to be correct. By the late 1980s, the number of Persian "MBB's" (Muslim Background Believers) had grown into many thousands. Then in the 1990s, two things converged to turn this momentum into one of the greatest watershed events in the history of Persian Christianity.

The first was a wave of government-organized crackdowns and assassinations of Christian leaders. The result of this was that hundreds of Persian lay leaders rose up to take the place of these martyrs and a nationwide house-church movement was born.

All of this was God's foundation-building for what would come next. In the year 2000, Christian satellite broadcasting began beaming the Gospel to almost every home in Iran. This was made possible by the fact that millions of satellite dishes had been illegally smuggled into Iran by corrupt members of the same government that had outlawed them. The Christian satellite programs became a lifeline for the Church in Iran.

Much more, when the Iranian people learned that the government was trying to scramble the broadcasts, they became an overnight sensation. Recent nationwide surveys reveal that over 70% of the population is watching Christian satellite programs. These same surveys indicate that at least one million have already become believers.

We read that Ezra "set his heart to study the Law of the Lord, and to do it and to teach it." Ezra

7:10. Four decisions are to be made to emulate Ezra's leadership commitment:

1. Set our hearts;

2. Study God's Word;

3. Apply and practice what we read; and

4. Teach others what we now know and experience.

Which of the four steps is the hard one for you? Setting your heart – even desiring to study? Or is it the application and practice part?

It seems like we sometimes jump to number 4 and start teaching what we have yet to apply to ourselves. I heard someone say that they could quickly tell the difference between a man who walked closely with the Lord and one who had recently read a good book.

As we pray today, may we focus on the priority of knowing and doing God's Word; that lies at the heart of every missionary endeavor. Pray that our missionaries (name two or three) would find the time in their busy schedules – and a quiet place - to study the Bible and listen to God.
